## **PUBLIC NOTICE OF Board Member Vacancy and Intent to Fill Vacancy by Appointment**

BALMD is responsible for the improvement, repair, operation, maintenance, works and other facilities that provide flood control and flood protection to the area encompassed by the combined levees of RD317 (Lower Andrus), RD407 (Andrus) and RD2067 (Brannan). Its governing board consists of five elected representatives. Two are designated "at-large". The remaining three represent RD317, RD407 and RD2067, one designated from each district.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** Brannan-Andrus Levee Maintenance District (BALMD) has a vacancy on the Board of Directors, effective March 31, 2026, due to the resignation of Harvey Correia, representing Reclamation District 2067, whose four-year term is due to expire with the November 2027 General Election; and, at which time, under statutory procedures established in California Government Code Section 1780, will be subject to election. Pursuant to said codes, the remaining Directors intend to interview applicants, selected according to the procedures set forth below, and consider appointment at their May 14, 2026 stated meeting to fill the unexpired term currently vacated.

Individuals interested in being considered for this appointment must:

**1. Meet Eligibility Requirement.** Individuals must meet the minimum eligibility requirement for the position, such requirements being:

- 1) Must own property within the boundaries of Reclamation District 2067 (Brannan); or
- 2) Be the legal representative of an owner of land within said District. "Legal representative" means an officer or other person or persons appointed to serve in that capacity by a landowner.

**2. File an Application Package.** Submit an Application Package to the District Secretary by the submittal deadline. The BALMD Board of Directors reserves the right to waive any irregularity in a submittal. Application documents are available via the District's website: **WWW.BALMD.ORG** or by contacting the District Secretary (see below).

A complete package consists of the following:

- 1) A Letter of Interest signed by the Applicant.
- 2) A completed Application for Consideration (attached).
- 3) If the Applicant is pursuing appointment as the representative of an owner of land within the boundary of Reclamation District 2067, the Applicant must attach a letter from said land owner establishing such relationship.

**3. Meet Filing Deadline.** Application packages must be **received** by the District Secretary no later than Noon (12:00 p.m.) of Friday, May 8, 2026. Applications may be emailed, hand-delivered, or sent via USPS. Applicants are responsible for verifying receipt with the District Secretary prior to the deadline.
